Course offer in German:

Students with sufficient German skills may also take classes in German upon agreement. The German courses offered at the USTP for incomings can be found here. Please contact the International Office if you wish to take classes in German that are not on the list, as not all classes are open to incoming exchange students.

Course selection for incoming students:

If needed, exchange students may mix lectures from different degree programmes, provided there are no time clashes.

This does not apply to iLab and EPS. EPS and iLab are offered as a fixed Project Modul and it is not foreseen that students take any extra courses here.

Subjects offered in the 1st, 3rd and 5th semester can only be chosen in the winter semester. Subjects offered in the 2nd, 4th and 6th semester can only be chosen in the summer semester.

Incoming students wishing to take subjects from the master's degree programmes must have sufficient knowledge of the respective subjects, as all of these courses are at an advanced level.
